

Permits

All vehicles entering the Transfer Station must have either an Annual Permit (available at the Town Clerk's Office for both residents **and** non-residents) or a Day Pass (available at the Transfer Station) for single day use by non-permit holders. Applications for Annual Permits are available at the TS, Town Hall and Town website and may be mailed in with a Self addressed stamped envelope.

Mixed Glass.....

Put lids in Co-Mingled bin. NO windows/ceramics.

Co-Mingled Plastic/Metal.....

Recycling codes #1, #2, #4, #5, #7, RINSED and gallons crushed; NO black-colored plastic OR plastic bags, EVEN IF they have a recycling code. Aluminum tins/foil must be cleaned FREE OF FOOD WASTE; if dirty, put in marked receptacle. NO toys, playground or computer equipment, paint cans, hangers, or Styrofoam.

Corrugated Cardboard & Brown Bags.....

Must be flattened. NO PLASTIC or STYROFOAM packaging materials. NO paperboard such as cereal/tissue boxes: put in Mixed Paper bin. Bubble wrap/packing peanuts put in marked receptacle.

Mixed Paper.....

N/C
Junk mail, phone books, soft covered books, newspaper, shredded paper. NO pizza boxes or wax coated cartons: put in Trash bin.

NY 5¢ Deposit Bottles & Cans.....

Includes water and carbonated drinks, accepted as donations to the Recycling Center. Glass deposits are collected in separate bins from plastic & cans. Thank you!
